

"Natural" WOODWIPE

Since the beginning of man wood has been shaped into utensils, bowls & chopping blocks.

Wood is practical, easily shaped and less likely to feed and hold bacteria. However, constant washing of wood has a tendency to soften the surface tissue and raise the fibres of the timber. - Therefore, it is necessary to regularly nourish or feed the timber to prevent this.


